It is your responsibility to verify your match records and ascertain your playoff eligibility by checking the information posted on-line.

Your record is final at 5pm the day following your last regular season game. If you have any questions about your record please contact Shane Clary, Program Assistant for Intramural Badminton so that it may be reviewed.

The 2009 Badminton post-season will begin **on Sunday, November 1st (women's) and Sunday November 8th (men's single, men's doubles, mixed doubles)**. The tournament format will be single-elimination. Playoff brackets will be posted on-line ONLY.

In order to be eligible for the playoffs, participants must:

- **Have no Forfeits or only 1 (one) Default during the regular season**

Participants will be seeded for the playoffs using the following system:

Participants will be seeded for the playoffs according to the strength of their playing schedule. Participants will receive points for each victory and lose points for each loss according to their opponent's final winning percentage. Ties are worth zero points. This final point total will be their strength of schedule rating and will be used to determine their seed in the tournament. If a tie exists, the following tie break method will be used: 1) head to head competition 2) coin toss. The following table will be used in seeding participants for the playoffs:

Opponent's final winning percentage	Points for a victory	Points for a loss
.000-.099	1	-9
.100-.199	1	-8
.200-.299	2	-7
.300-.399	3	-6
.400-.499	4	-5
.500-.599	5	-4
.600-.699	6	-3
.700-.799	7	-2
.800-.899	8	-1
.900-1.000	9	-1
