Sport Club  
-Point Reward System-**

The following point system will aid individual clubs in the budget allocation process. In this system, each sport club will have an opportunity to earn points for exceptional effort toward the overall improvement of their club. Coincidentally, clubs will earn negative points for certain policy infractions. At the end of the academic year, the points will be totaled and budget allocations will be determined based upon the club's overall point total. The following is a break down of the point system:

Acquisition of Points

+1	Properly attending financial training sessions/workshops
+1	Properly completing special event planning packet for on-campus events
+1	Properly getting travel approved
+1	Properly getting fundraising/sponsorship projects approved
+1	Properly getting academic consent approved
+3	Attending semester meeting with the Director of Recreational Services
+3	Properly completing annual registration process by established deadline
+5	Properly attending Fall general session
+5	Properly attending Spring general session
+5	Properly submitting budget proposal packet by the established deadline
+5	Properly presenting budget to the Sport Club Council

Deterioration of Points

-1	Failure to attend financial training sessions/workshops
-1	Failure to complete special event planning packet for on-campus events
-1	Failure to get travel approved
-1	Failure to get fundraising/sponsorship projects approved
-1	Failure to get academic consent approved
-3	Failure to attend semester meeting with the Director of Recreational Services
-3	Failure to complete annual registration process by established deadline
-5	Failure to attend Fall general session
-5	Failure to attend Spring general session
-5	Failure to submit budget proposal packet by the established deadline
-5	Failure to present budget to the Sport Club Council

The point total for each club will carry over from year to year and will be a continual and consistent measure of the overall quality of the individual sport club. Point totals will not be made public. Clubs will be notified of their point total on an individual basis with the Director of Recreational Services.

During the budget application process, clubs will be eligible for a percentage of their overall operational budget based upon their corresponding point total. For example, a club that has earned 50 points will be eligible for an allocation that equals 50 percent of its operational budget. This is only the amount the club is eligible for. Individual allocations are determined by the sport club council and are sensitive to the total amount allocated for sport club use by the University.

Yearly sport club allocations may vary from year to year due to extenuating circumstances. In any case, clubs should expect to fundraise and plan accordingly in order to accomplish their goals. There are no guarantees that clubs will receive funding from the University.
