Intramural Sports
Basketball (3-point competition)
-Rules of the Game-**

The rules below are specific for the sport indicated above and do not include intramural program policies which all participants must abide by. For a complete description of intramural policies, participants should view the Intramural Program Manual.

National Intramural Recreational Sport Association (NIRSA) rules govern any rule not mentioned in this document.

1. The order of participation is determined by the order in which each person has signed in.
2. Participants will be limited to one attempt.
3. Five (5) balls will be shot from each of the five designated positions on the three point arc. The first four (4) balls of each rack will be worth one (1) point while the fifth ball ("The Money Ball") of each rack will be worth two (2) points.
4. Each participant has 60 seconds to shoot all 25 balls.
5. Both feet of the shooter must be behind the 3-point line in order for the shot to count.
6. The Intramural staff member in charge will make all necessary decisions regarding the event.
7. Champions will be determined by the highest point total in each division (Men's and Women's). Ties will be broken by the number of shots made. If a tie is still in effect, multiple champions will be recognized.
